

CITY OF GEORGETOWN, STATE OF IDAHO
ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE 99, SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 21 OF THE ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THAT A VIOLATION OF SECTION 9 AT LARGE DOGS, AND SECTION 10 DISTURBING THE PEACE, IS AN INFRACTION, AND ESTABLISHING THE PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF SECITON 9 AND 10.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, IDAHO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: SECTION 21 OF ORDINANCE 99 IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 21 VOILATION PENALTY A violation of Section 9, At Large Dog, and Section 10, Disturbing the Peace, shall be an infraction. The penalty for a conviction for a first offense infraction violation of Section 9 or 10 shall be a fine of \$100.00. A conviction for a second offense violation of Section 9 or 10 shall be a fine of \$200.00. Any third or subsequent conviction for violation of Section 9 or 10 shall be a fine of \$300.00. Any other violation of this chapter by the owner, keeper or harbinger of said animal, except for violations of the licensing requirements, shall be deemed a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, said owner, keeper, or harbinger shall be subject to a fine, up to one thousand dollars (\$1000.00). There shall be no jail time imposed for violation of this ordinance.

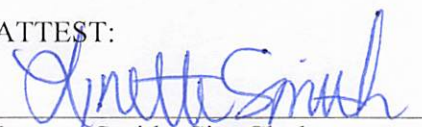
Section 2: EFFECTIVE DATE: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

Section 3: THREE READING RULE: One half (1/2) plus one (1) of the members of the full council agree to dispense with the rule requiring the reading of this ordinance on three (3) separate occasions.
